IMPORTANT NOTES

- CPF Submission Number (CSN)
 - Domestic Employer**
Your CSN is your Singapore NRIC or Foreign Identification Number (FIN) used when applying for a domestic worker (e.g. S-1234567-A, F-1234567-A, G-1234567-A).
 - Business Employer**
Your CSN is your Unique Entity Number (UEN) and CPF Payment Code (e.g. 12345678A-PTE-01, 200812345A-PTE-01).
 - Individual trading under own name** (e.g. architect/engineer or individual hiring local personal driver/gardener)
Your CSN is your NRIC/FIN and CPF Payment code (e.g. S/F/G1234567A-PTE-01).

- Payment should be made by 14th of the month, following the liability month. If the 14th falls on a Saturday, Sunday or public holiday, the payment must be made by the next working day. Penalty interest of 2% per month or \$5 (whichever is higher) will be charged for late payment, up to a maximum of 30% of the outstanding levy. You can pay via the following modes:
 - NETS**
Payment using NETS can be made at any SingPost office. You can also use NETS to pay your domestic foreign worker levy at iNETS kiosk and SAM machine.
 - Cash**
Cash payment can only be made at Singapore Post office. Please do not send cash via post.
 - Cash Card/FlashPay Card**
Cash card/ FlashPay card can be used to pay domestic FWL at iNETS kiosk. You may also use cash card to pay business and domestic FWL at any SingPost office.
 - Cheque**
Cheque should be crossed and made payable to the CPF Board. The reverse side of each cheque should indicate:
(i) 'For FWL Payment' (ii) CPF Submission Number (iii) Name of Employer (iv) Contact Number
The Board does not accept post-dated cheque.
 - Diners Club Credit Card/D-Pay (ATM cards)**
Payment by Diners Club Credit Card/D-Pay (ATM cards) can be made at any AXS station.
 - eNETS (also known as Internet Banking)**
You can perform eNETS through the iFWLB website www.mom.gov.sg > Services and Forms > Internet Foreign Worker Levy Billing system (iFWLB). You would need your SingPass and an Internet Banking account with DBS, UOB, OCBC or Citibank. To obtain a SingPass, please visit www.singpass.gov.sg.
- Please bring along this payment advice when you pay your levy at SingPost office. CPF Service Centres only accept cheque payment.
